Dear Mr. Briscoe:

We are in receipt of your request under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

On January 12, 2017, we received your request for copies of any surveillance camera video and/or audio during the attempted apprehension of a homicide suspect on a Milwaukee North Metra train around 10:30 p.m. on Jan. 9, in addition to the ensuing shootout and the evacuation of passengers. Requested video and audio includes, but is not limited to, footage recorded by cameras inside Metra railcar No. 7424 and at the Lake Cook Metra station. (“**Request**”).

After performing a diligent search of Metra’s records, we have been unable to locate any records responsive to your Request. Metra’s Police Department does not have the requested records. You may contact the Illinois State Police as they are the primary investigative unit for this matter.
