We are in receipt of your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

On February 8, 2017, we received your request for a copy of a police report regarding windshield damage to a Metra vehicle which had been parked at the Oak Lawn parking lot on 95th Street for an extended period of time (“**Request**”).

I spoke with you on February 8, after learning a police report had not been filed for this incident and informed you that the Metra Police department asked that you call them to file a report. You stated you would follow-up with the police department.

On Monday, February 13, I spoke to you again regarding your Request and asked if you filed a report. You stated that a report was filed and the Metra vehicle had been removed for repair. I asked if you still wanted a copy of the report, and you stated you did not need it now. As such, Metra will consider your Request for this report closed.
