We are in receipt of your request under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

On March 22, 2017, we received your request for a police report for an injury to yourself that occurred outside the CVS near Union Station on April 2, 2016 at 12:19 p.m.
