The Kendall Extension Study Project Team, in coordination with Metra, invite you to an open house regarding the extension of commuter rail service into Kendall County. The Kendall Extension Study has been initiated to study the feasibility of extending the BNSF commuter rail line beyond its existing terminus in Aurora. This study will examine new outlying yard locations in addition to new commuter rail stations at Montgomery, Oswego, Yorkville, Plano and Sandwich, Illinois.

Two identical open house meetings will provide an opportunity for attendees to learn about the overall project including the study elements and station location options. The open house format will allow the public to learn about the study, view exhibits and provide comments. While there is no formal presentation, project staff will be available to answer questions.
